SPRING SEMESTER GENERAL FACULTY MEETING Friday, May 2, 2008 Vice President Tim Goodman, Presiding

The Spring Semester General Faculty Meeting began promptly at 2 p.m. in the newly renovated East Georgia College at Statesboro site on Fair Road.

Vice President Tim Goodman

Dr. Tim Goodman, vice president for academic affairs at East Georgia College, welcomed the faculty to the spring faculty meeting. The first order of business was the approval of the prior semester's faculty minutes. The faculty approved the fall semester 2007 minutes.

Vice President Goodman next brought Mary Smith, vice president for legal and external affairs, to the podium. She introduced Elizabeth Gilmer, the new director of development and alumni affairs at East Georgia College. Ms. Gilmer talked about the upcoming fundraising campaign and the letters and pledge forms that were recently mailed to the faculty and staff.

President John Black

Dr. Black briefly gave an update on the Chancellor's knee surgery, student housing campaign at EGC, and stressed the importance of the upcoming fundraising campaign that Ms. Gilmer discussed in her presentation.

The President acknowledged Drs. Tori Kearns, Glenn Stracher, and Tommy Upchurch and their books that were recently published. He also acknowledged Mary Smith, David Gribbin and several others on three enhancement grants awarded to EGC from the University System.

Dr. Black distributed a handout with the new East Georgia College Alma Mater by Andrew Darley, Class of Spring, 2008.

Vice President Goodman

Dr. Goodman brought Dr. Dee McKinney to the podium. Dr. McKinney reminded the faculty about several tasks to be completed for online classes and also about the posting of grades and summer syllabi on VISTA.

Vice President Goodman continued by discussing Degree Works and training for faculty, as well as some other advising efforts that were in the works.

He moved next to the review of the core curriculum that has begun and gave a short update to the faculty on this process. More information will be covered in the future on this review.

Dr. Goodman moved next to activity within the academic policies committee and referred to a handout on this topic. These topics include the international baccalaureate credit program. The faculty voted to accept the program. A theater appreciation course was another topic of discussion, as well as several other changes within the Humanities Division to bring courses in line with other institutions within the University System. The faculty voted to make the course description changes.

He proceeded by discussing changes to a course (Calculus-based physics) by making it officially calculus based. The faculty voted to approve the change. The faculty also approved the addition of a problem-solving course (Science in Society) in the Mathematics/Science Division.

These courses will be added to the fall schedule.

He next moved to a vote by the faculty to approve the graduates for spring semester. The faculty approved the graduates.

Dr. Goodman briefly acknowledged copyright infringement in online courses with the faculty. This will be monitored in the future. He continued by discussing student advising and the importance of this process. He also briefly discussed the "Pull 200" advising project, which he is executing in his office.

David Gribbin, director of institutional research, mentioned the upcoming SACS review in two years and the need to begin preparing for this review.

In closing, Dr. Goodman mentioned the upcoming "Pine Tree Festival" and encouraged participation in this community event.

A motion was made and passed to adjourn the meeting. The meeting adjourned at 4:35 p.m.
